TOWN OF EDISTO BEACH PROCLAMATION RECOGNIZING THE HONARABLE REVEREND WILLIAM HANCE "BILL" ALSTON

WHEREAS, the Honorable Bill Alston was born in Awendaw, SC to the late Rev. Warren and Rebecca Dingle Alston; and

WHEREAS, Rev. Bill Alston honorably served his country in the United States Navy for three years; and

WHEREAS, Rev. Bill Alston graduated from Allen University, earning a Bachelor of Science degree in three years; and

WHEREAS, following graduation, Rev. Bill Alston served Pilgrim Health and Life Insurance Company of Augusta, GA in the Charleston and Savannah districts; and

WHEREAS, Rev. Bill Alston then served as the Head of the Business Department at Lincoln High School in McClellanville, SC for six years; and

WHEREAS, desiring to be an asset to the Civil Rights Movement, Rev. Bill Alston then joined forces with the Political Action Committee (PAC) of Charleston County; and

WHEREAS, because of Rev. Bill Alston, many improvements were made in the community, including the establishment of the Head Start Child Development Program and the establishment of a Charleston County Library branch; and

WHEREAS, the Rev. Bill Alston served the AME Church as pastor and administrator for 40 years, and under his leadership the building of five churches and life cycle centers became a reality; and

WHEREAS, Rev. Alston served as the first mayor of the Town of Awendaw and President of the SC Conference of Black Mayors from 2000 - 2002; and

WHEREAS, Rev. Alston served Allen AME Church on Edisto and Calvary AME Church for a number of years and retired from Greater Macedonia AME Church; and

WHEREAS, Rev. Alston received many awards including the Order of the Palmetto in 2005 and served on many boards and committees, including the AME Ministers' Alliance, The Interdenominational Ministers Alliance, and the Charleston Branch of the NAACP.

THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that Edisto Beach Town Council formally recognizes the Honorable Reverend William Hance "Bill" Alston and thanks him for his many years of dedicated service.
