Prioritization:

Susan Hornsby at the July Council meeting asked the TIDE Committee to prioritize beach access improvements.

1-A is closed

29 is closed

2,4,5,6,7 closed to parking

3 is golf cart parking only

Janet Oakley commented that it is the goal of the TIDE Committee to reclaim areas and that has been done. She asked for recommendations from the committee members.

Mickey Van Metre moved to open beach accesses 1-A, 2, 5, 6, 20 and 29 for the parking of vehicles/golf carts on those that can accommodate parking. Archie Livingston seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Archie Livingston moved to prioritize the beach access improvements with the numbers in sequence and stated that it is the goal of the TIDE Committee to strive to open all accesses to vehicle parking where possible. Charlie Boozer seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Burley Lyons Park Wayfinder Signs:

Charlie Boozer moved to recommend to council for signs to be erected on Jungle Road and Palmetto Boulevard for scenic park signs designating the Burley Lyons Park. Mickey Van Metre seconded and the motion carried unanimously.
