MINUTES TIDE COMMITTEE May 31, 2017

Old Business:

Burley Lyons Park Way Finding Sign – Patrick Brown stated that the sign ordinance has gone through first reading and is scheduled for second reading on June 8th at the Council meeting. Marie Bost moved to recommend to Council to approve the sign size being small such as the bike path sign. Peter Beck seconded and the motion carried unanimously. This item will be put back on the agenda after second reading is completed.

New Business:

Status of Beach Accesses – Bob Doub stated that West Bank has completed the stabilization. Brian Zlogar needs to finish bike racks and benches and has a few more accesses to finish to complete the beach access project.

Prioritization of Beach Accesses – Marie Bost visited all accesses on Memorial Day and took pictures. She commented that, amazingly enough, everyone seemed to know how to park. She recommended that we leave parking alone for the time being and concentrate on cleaning the debris (vegetation, etc.). The consensus of the committee was at this time to let Brian continue his work and to visit the accesses and make recommendations at the July meeting on dealing with vegetation to maximize parking. Janet asked for a list of accesses that have agreements/encroachments so they will know what they are dealing with.

Marie Bost called on Councilman Kizer for comments at this time. He stated the committee needs to look at what material they will recommend to Council to put on the walkovers at the beach accesses (board, mobi-mat, etc.), and to specifically look at Beach Access 36.
