## **New Business:**

\$30,000.00 has been donated to the volunteer fire dept. and we need to work on Thank You notes. Chief Conley will order pre-stamped post cards printed with Thank you on them. We will address and stuff them next meeting, October 25<sup>th</sup>.

We are "sitting" on a lot of donation money-\$97000.00 plus. Plans to use it: new barracks, 2<sup>nd</sup> bathroom, expansion on building; new floor. But we need to vote on this usage of funds next meeting.

October 20<sup>th</sup> is Fall Festival from 11-4 on Jungle Road. We need VOLUNTEERS to sell t-shirts, which is our main fundraiser behind donations, that day. Scott asked that Bess ask Cindy Lenz to put out a signup sheet to sell shirts that day via email.

## **Training:**

Target Solutions participation: we have spent \$4300.00 on it, and it is not getting used! We need to do these assignments people.

**Financial Report**: Scott Epps read it to us for information.

## **Chief's Report:**

Volunteer participation: Participation by volunteers has fallen off greatly. Chief will send out a letter to all volunteers on roster who have not been attending meetings; and if no better response, they will be removed from volunteering.

Discussion about the locking of the Ice Machine and other doors. We don't own it; it belongs to the Town and not the general public. Our people were coming in and taking 5-8 bags of ice without asking anyone, plus stuff out of the store rooms. So the Chief put a lock on them. It was getting out of hand. If you want some ice or whatever, then kindly ask.

I and I budget: \$29000.00 to be used for trainings, insurance, jackets, hats, weight equipment, etc. This is the stuff the town does not buy.
