"Drive-On" Dock Resolution

WHEREAS, the Town of Edisto Beach has a water rescue boat that is docked at Bay Creek Park; and

WHEREAS, the time to respond to calls for assistance is critical; and

WHEREAS, the boat has to be taken out of service periodically to maintain the hull: and

WHEREAS, by utilizing a "drive-on" dock, the boat can stay in service for longer periods of time; and

WHEREAS, a "drive-on" dock improves response time during critical water rescue situations; and

WHEREAS, Department of Natural Resources Water Recreation Funds are available and may be utilized for the purchase of said "drive-on" dock; and

WHEREAS, the Colleton County Legislative Delegation can authorize spending of Water Recreation funds.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Town of Edisto Beach Town Council requests Colleton County Legislative Delegation authorize the purchase of a "drive-on" dock at Bay Creek Park using Water Recreation Funds.
