



August King Tides are predicted along South Carolina's coast Tuesday through Thursday. This series coincides with Wednesday's new moon. The highest tides will occur in the evenings, and water levels are predicted to peak at 6.7' above mean lower low water (MLLW) in Charleston Harbor on Wednesday evening. Predicted high tides relative to MLLW at the [Charleston Harbor](#) tide station are shown in the table below, with King Tides in bold. For predicted water levels along the southern coast, refer to NOAA's tide station at [Fort Pulaski, GA](#). For water levels along the northern coast, refer to NOAA's [Springmaid Pier](#) tide station.
