Hurricane Nicole Beach Erosion



Edisto Beach suffered significant heach erosion as a result of Hurricane Nicole this November. Wave action topped the dunes bringing sand and water onto Palmetto Boulevard causing road closures and sand removal from the road. The 2022 Atlantic Hurricane Season officially ends on November 30th.

Vine Street Bike Path Upgrade

Edisto Beach was recently awarded a \$125,000 South Carolina Land and Water Conservation Fund grant to be applied towards improving the Vine Street Bike The project includes Path. repaving the almost one mile long bike path to its original condition. The Vine Street Bike Path runs from Edisto Street to Sunset Street. The Town received state and federal endorsements for this project from U.S. Representative Nancy Mace, Senator Tim Scott, and State Senator Chip Campson.
