Beach Etiquette and Safety

- ✓ Respect personal space. Allow 4-12 feet between parties on the beach.
- \checkmark Turn the volume down. Not everyone likes the same music or wants to hear conversations or phone calls.
- ✓ Leash your pets. Dog bites can ruin your visit to the beach.
- ✓ Watch surf advisories. If the surf is rough, stay out of the water. Each beach access has a life buoy and directions on how to navigate rip tides.
- ✓ STAY OFF THE GROINS! They are not for walking or fishing.

Edisto Beach Master Recreation Plan

The Town's master recreation plan is finally complete after numerous meetings and input from the public. This plan provides a road map for the recreation needs of Edisto Beach now and in the future. This plan is essential for finding alternative funding for project implementation. Council will be providing approval as each component is addressed in phasing and implementation.

Water Leak Adjustments

Council approved first reading of Ordinance 2021-21 dealing to address how to handle bill adjustments for water leaks. With the new bond ordinance and bond issue, water adjustments will be handled differently than in the past. Because the water produced has a cost associated with it (i.e. chemicals, filters, electric), our bond prohibits a waiver of fees. The new ordinance provides adjustment to the sewer portion based on the average of the previous three billing cycles. The water portion can be paid over a six-month period without penalty provided payments are not late.
