

The Importance of Septic Tank Maintenance

Regularly servicing your septic system can save you money and can protect your property value, health and the environment. Because Edisto Beach has such a high water table, it's especially important to ensure your septic tank is working properly and not leaking into the ground. It's recommended that septic tanks be inspected every one to three years and pumped every three to five years. The frequency of pumping will depend on tank size and number of people in the household, as well as water use habits. Septic tanks are permitted to the number of bedrooms in a house. Lowcountry Area Agency on Aging Programs

The Lowcountry Council of Governments (LCOG) is one of ten South Carolina councils designed to serve as a connection between local governments and state and federal programs. The LCOG, which serves Colleton County, has a variety of programs and resources available to the Town of Edisto Beach and its citizens. Among their programs is the Lowcountry Area Agency on Aging. The agency provides insurance counseling, legal assistance, long-

Town Lobbyist Efforts

The Town hired Mr. Kenneth Bingham of Adams and Reese LLP in 2022 to serve as a licensed lobbyist representing various town interests. Mr. Bingham assisted the Town's efforts by successfully lobbying the state's aeneral assembly for the inclusion of 7.5 million dollars of matching funds for the Town's Storm Reduction project with the Army Corps of Engineers. Other matters Mr. Bingham will be representing include the Town's 10 million dollar grant application for sewer upgrades and assisting the town correcting our previous Census count which would impact



the Town's American Rescue Funds allotment.

Short-Term Rental Compliance

The Town recently partnered with a software company (Granicus) to assist the town with short-term rental monitoring and compliance. The software will track real-time rental advertisements and bookings to ensure that all rental owners are remitting the correct



accommodations taxes to the town. This program will also allow the town to ensure that properties rental properly licensed through the town.
