## **Fetter Health Care Network announces Walterboro and Edisto Island COVID-19 vaccine clinics**

**Charleston, SC** – Fetter Health Care Network (Fetter) announced it will be hosting COVID-19 vaccination clinics in Walterboro and Edisto Island in the coming weeks. Vaccines will be distributed on a first-come, first-serve basis and no appointment is needed. Fetter offers single-dose Johnson & Johnson and Moderna vaccine clinics across the Lowcountry. The emergency use authorization allows these vaccines to be distributed to individuals 18 years of age and older.

Individuals who qualify should arrive at the clinic and complete an on-site registration. Individuals are asked to anticipate a moderate wait time, as previous clinics have been well attended. It is also encouraged that recipients refrain from arriving prior to 30 minutes before the start of the vaccine clinics.

"We are continuing to serve the Lowcountry as vaccines become available for our team to administer," said Aretha R. Powers, DHA, CEO of Fetter. "Each clinic is designed with our community members in mind, as we aim to overcome hurdles such as transportation or appointment availability for individuals in need."
